UPDATE: Childcare Oversupply
 Federal Minister for Education, the Hon Dan Tehan MP, confirms receipt of ACA NSW's proposal.
 Proposal was to enable release of aggregated quarterly statistics of attendances to help inform prospective new entrants.
 Minister Tehan's Office wrote to ACA NSW saying they will consider this post COVID-19.

UPDATE: Proposal to abolish NSW Payroll Tax





- NSW Treasurer Perrottet proposes to abolish NSW Payroll Tax
- \$150m will be saved annually by 1,945 ECEC services.
- Proposal is anticipated to be announced as part of May 2020 budget at NSW Parliament.

BACKGROUND:

- ACA NSW has been advocated for increasing the threshold to at least \$2m.
- NSW Government decided to increase the threshold from \$500,000 to \$1m by 30 June 2021.
