

- To be available only between the Regulatory Authority and the Approved Provider:
  - 1. List of all breaches & non-compliances since 2012 that **do not** attract financial penalties
  - 2. List of all breaches & non-compliances since 2012 that **do** attract financial penalties
  - 3. List of breaches to be listed as table(s) (ie active, withdrawn, with+without financial penalty, etc)
  - 4. Escalation paths to the NSW Civil Administrative Tribunal (NCAT) and/or courts
  - 5. Every breach/non-compliance to carry records of issuing officer, evidence, responses, resolution(s).
  - 6. Guarantee that unsubstantiated and withdrawn breaches/non-compliances cannot be used against the Approved Provider(s).
  - 7. Records to be kept and made available to Approved Providers as long as their service(s) remains active.
